TRAINING ON SEA

Presentation will show the main goals in SEA implementation and the development of the system at EU level and in Slovenia. It presents the legislation transposition of SEA Directive in Slovenia in Environmental Law and Decree on SEA. The SEA implementations experiences in last ten years will be present him on programme and plan level. The process of consultation in SEA screening, scoping and SEA report quality will be present in such a way that it will help in development of administrative measures in training states.

All steps in SEA like consultation and public participation will be present and the transparency of the process shows, including the alternative assessment.

Appropriate assessment is presented in line with Art 6 (3) and (4) of Habitats directive and its links with the system as well as Rules for methodology.

TRAINING ON EIA

Development of EIA system in Slovenia is presented and legislation in EIA. Environmental Law solutions and decrees will be shown and described the main points. The improvements in 30 years' time and development of legislation will be shown.

All main steps in EIA will be shown like EIA consultation, public participation and final environmental decision acceptance as well as their links in building permit.
