Screening

- ☐ Inappropriate transposition of Directives
- ☐ Avoiding implementation of assessments
- ☐ Poor explanation why SEA, EIA or AA are not needed



Scoping

- ☐ Not implemented at all
- ☐ Not focused on the main environmental and nature protection issues
- ☐ Huge and non focused documents (environmental reports)

Assessment

- ☐ All assesment based on experts oppinion
- ☐ Weak data/baseline for assessment
- ☐ Assessment of non relevant impacts
- ☐ Pro forma assessment

Mitigation measures

- ☐ Unrealistic mitigation measures
- ☐ No monitoring of implementation of mitigation measures foreseen
- ☐ Mitigation measures not included into plans/projects

Consultation

- ☐ Only required consultation
- ☐ Lack of active consultation
- ☐ No targeted consultation

- ☐ Implementation of assessment in late stages of
